Battery assembly negative pole grounding principle

Can a negative battery terminal be ground?

This is a common question that comes up when you're looking to ground something in your car. While the negative terminal on your battery might look like it should be grounded, most batteries are “negative ground” systems which means they cannot be used as ground battery terminal.

Do battery accessories need a chassis ground?

Some of my accessories have instructions to ground to the negative terminal on the battery while others just need a chassis ground. My logic is that the negative battery terminal is grounded to the chassis so the two must be one of a kind. However, the more I think about, the more I think my logic is missing something.

Why should a battery be grounded straight to the battery post?

This resistance will cause a voltage drop (even in the ground side). Components that will have large amounts of amperage flowing through them (like your fuse box) should be grounded straight to the battery post to help decrease the distance the current has to travel to get back to the battery negative post.

Can a negative lead be grounded?

Grounding a negative lead can create hazardous conditions when there is a direct current path through internal circuitry to any external conductors, such as cabinet screws, enclosures, jacks, connectors, and wire leads. In these cases, it is not recommended to ground the negative lead to the negative battery or supply terminal.

Where should a battery negative post connect?

The battery negative post and battery negative leads should connect only to major grounds, such as the engine block (very heavy lead for alternator and starter current) and the vehicle chassis for all other devices.

Battery Negative or Positive Ground?: I'm Trying to Rewire...

Any vehicles with a positive ground go back to at least the 1950s or older. The reason we connect the negative last is simply for safety. As you're wrenching away, if the wrench were to contact anything metal on the car while touching the nut on the cable clamp, nothing will happen.

Grounding Negative of Trailer Battery to the Chassis

You can ground anything to that body because the ground path is designed for hundreds of amps from the starter motor. An older chevy truck might have a battery negative that makes a pit stop on the frame before continuing to the engine block but only a 10 gauge wire goes to the fender/body. So, it depends.

Electrons move from negative battery pole to the positive pole in a circuit. The "ground" has a different meaning compared to normal household electricity (alternating current). There is no "ground" if you disconnect the negative battery terminal. We are not dealing with earth ground references here, it is a battery that chemically produces a difference of potential (voltage) between the - and + terminals. And besides, the 12V won't hurt you even if you break the circuit and then "connect" it with your body.

If you mean the first ground, the question doesn't make sense as ground is the same as the negative side of the battery. And if you mean the second, nothing will happen, as you aren't closing a circuit.

Is it really necessary to connect more than one negative ground ...

I'm with twinboat and gpounder. You don't need to connect to each ground wire individually - you just need to be sure your shunt is in the battery ground path for every device. If everything else passes through the chassis "ground bus", then placing the shunt between negative terminal and the chassis is sufficient.

Eli5: Why do we consider the negative terminal of battery "ground"...

For AC system, like most are when there is a physical connection to the physical ground you have both positive and negative voltages.
