Overview

Frequently Asked Questions

What if I can't enter the BIOS?

If you can't enter the BIOS, you can try: Clear CMOS: Turn off the power, unplug the power cord, open the computer case, and find the CMOS battery (a round battery) on the motherboard. Remove the battery for a few minutes, then put it back, and try to start again. Alternatively, use the CMOS jumper on the motherboard to clear the settings.

How do I restart my computer if I can't enter the BIOS?

1. Shut down: Press and hold the power button for a few seconds to force the computer to shut down. 2. Enter the BIOS: When you restart the computer, immediately press the F2 or Delete key (depending on your motherboard model) and press it continuously until you enter the BIOS interface. If you can't enter the BIOS, you can try:

Why is my PC not booting into BIOS?

If your PC won't boot into BIOS, then likely there is something broken in it. Or, some settings or tweaks are out of the way. The BIOS settings are made to help you troubleshoot, tweak, etc. So, if your PC cannot enter BIOS, then there could be a few issues, such as: If your PC won't go into BIOS, then it's likely it's one of these issues.

Why is my BIOS not loading?

Usually, the issue could be due to having the Fast Startup option enabled. It overrides BIOS and causes an error message when you try to load it. At the same time, the BIOS loads problem could be due to your computer system being outdated, your BIOS battery being corrupt, or having loose RAM sticks.

Why can't I get into the BIOS menu?

Many factors can cause the BIOS (or UEFI) to become inaccessible, from the system freezing to not seeing the prompt appear. If you can't get into the BIOS menu, here are some troubleshooting steps you can try. 1. Plug in a wired keyboard Let's start with the most obvious reason.

Why is my Motherboard not loading Windows 10?

If you have a monitor plugged into your GPU, your motherboard may suddenly go straight to loading Windows. Older motherboards don't work this way, but some newer boards will skip the BIOS prompt if they don't immediately detect output from the GPU. To rule out this problem, go to where your monitor is plugged in.

PC won't POST and can't enter BIOS

Both of those LED codes point toward a system board failure. You can try replacing the CMOS battery as that system is approaching 10 years old and the battery may be weak. As per the service manual that battery is a CR2032. If that does not help then a system board has probably failed.

Can't get to BIOS on an MSI motherboard

Open the case and identify the CMOS battery - it is like a big hearing-aid battery. Carefully remove the battery. Now hold down the power button to drain any residual power from the motherboard. Re-attach the battery and now reboot the computer pressing Delete key or F8 or F2 (etc.) keys to reach the BIOS.

Remove the motherboard CMOS battery for five minutes. In some cases it may be necessary to remove the graphics card to access the CMOS battery. During that five minutes, press the power button on the case, continuously, for 30 seconds.

As you have removed the CMOS backup battery, your BIOS settings have been lost and you will need to restore them. Except in the case where the default BIOS settings were fine, your computer will not boot until you do that. Press the key to enter BIOS setup during boot, and review your BIOS settings and set any that are incorrect.

Do I Need to Replace the Battery on My Motherboard? Signs, ...

Incorrect System Date and Time: The issue of incorrect system date and time occurs when the motherboard battery loses its charge. This battery maintains the real-time clock that keeps track of time even when the computer is powered off.

Can't boot after BIOS changes, removing CMOS battery ...

The I couldn't get into the motherboard bios is because my graphics card (1070) was outputting to screens via displayport 1.4, but the firmware of the card could only output via displayport 1.3. This meant that there was no graphical output until Windows loaded, which had the appropriate display adapter to output to displayport 1.4.

Now, plug the power supply cable back in, switch the PSU back on and power up the system. It should display the POST screen and the options to enter CMOS/BIOS setup.
