Are energy subsidies phasing out in Egypt?

Phasing out energy subsidies is high on the agenda of policymakers in several Middle Eastern and North African countries. The impact of such reform can vary widely depending on the country and policy. This paper contributes to the existing literature by examining the phasing out of energy subsidies in Egypt under alternative economic scenarios.

How did Egypt's energy subsidy reform impact the economy?

This paper examines the short- and long-run economic impact of Egypt's energy subsidy reform in July 2014 (with-out and without compensating transfers for the bottom 40 percent of the income distribution) and the decline in global energy prices, as well as the long-run impact of phasing out the energy subsidies over a 5 year period.

When did Egypt re-introduce a phase-out of energy subsidies?

In July 2014 the Egyptian government re-introduced major reforms to phase-out energy subsidies through a staged series of increases in the officially mandated prices for petroleum, gas and electricity.



How does the energy subsidy reform affect the private sector?

Thus, in the long term, the energy subsidy reform not only increases energy prices and intermediate input cost, but also the cost of public services, thereby hampering growth and income generation in the private sector.

Will EGP 2 trillion be needed in Egypt's energy sector?

The International Finance Corporation (IFC) believes that EGP 2 Trillion are required to be brought into Egypt's energy sector in climate-smart investments by 2030. Egypt is expected to overtake South Africa in the next decade to become the largest electricity market in Africa.

How much FDI is needed in Egypt's energy sector?

FDI is concentrated in the oil and gas industry (around three-quarters of total investments), followed by real estate, manufacturing, financial services and construction.
