Frequently Asked Questions

Where should a photocell be located?

For example, if the lighting system is being used to illuminate a parking lot, the photocell should be located near the edge of the lot, facing away from the lights. This will ensure that the photocell is not affected by the light from the fixtures and that the lights are turned on when necessary.

How high should a photocell be?

For most applications, a height of between 6-8 feet is recommended. Additionally, the photocell should be angled in such a way that it is facing the area that will be illuminated by the lights. This will ensure that the photocell accurately detects changes in light levels and turns the lights on or off as required.

What are photocells used for?

The primary purpose of a photocell is to save energy by reducing the use of artificial lighting when natural light is sufficient.

What Direction Should a Photocell Face?

The mounting angle of the photocell is also important to consider. The photocell should be mounted between 6-8 feet of the window area, central to the area illuminated by the electrical lighting that will be controlled. In all cases, the photocell must be mounted so that it looks at reflected light only and not at any direct light.
